The existence of Navagrahaswas initially unearthed from Sanskrit as it was briefed as 'Nav' refers to 'Nine' and 'Graha' refers to the 'Planet'. Navagraha are the nine heavenly bodies and deities that influence human life on Earth as per the Hinduism and Hindu astrology (Roshen Dalal, (2010). [1]). In many of the earlier studies and with reference to mythology, it is comprehended that even the Sun is one among the Navagraha and it is said as a solar system. Initially, the five planets were visible to the naked eye by excluding the earth from a solar system, were said by many of the scientific and mythological theories and they proved that there are nine and a sun complied to become a solar system (Monier Williams, (1899). [2]). To understand the concept of planets in deep, these solar systems were related to the seven days of a week in a calendar and the same resembles to seven classical planets and are named correspondingly in most languages of the Indian Sub continent. According to (Dikshitar, (2020). [3]), most Hindu temples around the world have a designated place dedicated to Navagraha worship and the history beyond the same is vast and purely mythological. Based on this mythological history, it is observed that these nine planets continue to reside in Tamil Nadu and shower blessings on their devotees. According to (Vijaylaxmi Thakur, (2010). [4]) these nine temples dedicated to Navagraha were built in Tamil Nadu. These planets include Surya (Sun), Chandra (Moon), Mangala (Mars), Budha (Mercury), Brihaspathi (Jupiter), Sukhra (Venus), Shani (Saturn), Rahu and Ketu. Many of the mythologists and ancient gurus have expressed that, these Navagrahas are controlled by only Lord Shiva and called Navagraheshwara and that is the reason these Navagrahas are placed in temples of lord Shiva. From Vedas, these Navagrahas are more concerted on the prearrangement of these planets and their connotation on the world from the time of birth to their life existence, including their sustainability, growth, development and many other aspects, hence these Navagrahas are found in every temple. Even though these Navagrahas are worshipped there is only one temple exclusively for the praying of these Navagrahason the outskirts of Ujjain (Temple Purohit, (2019). [5]).

The nine months of fetal development are ruled by a Navagrahas. It is also believed that if there is any weakness in the Navagrahas at the time of conception, it could lead to issues in fetal development ruled by that particular Graha. According to Varahamihira, the natural significance of fetal development with respect to the planetary gods is the First month is ruled by Sukhra (Venus) also called *Kalala* which is the time the conception proceeds. There will be no distinct form this month, yet all organs will develop in the latent form. The Second month is ruled by Mangala (Mars) and is also referred to as Ghana which denotes 'solidified' relating to the densification of the embryo. The Third month is ruled by Brihaspathi (Jupiter) and is also called Ankura which means to sprout, all the sense organs, internal organs and limbs of the body will get manifested in this month by the influence of Jupiter. The Fourth month is ruled by the Surya (Sun) and is also called Asthi which denotes the 'bone'. In this month fetus will develop a particular structure. The Fifth month is ruled by Chandra (Moon) also referred to as the Carma which means 'skin' which grows in excess, and the pigmentary and sensory development increases. The Sixth month is ruled by Shani (Saturn) and is also called *Angaja* which means produced from the body and represents the hair and nails growth. Locomotor control in the brain will develop this month. The Seventh month is ruled by Budha (Mercury) and is called Cetana-ta which denotes the state of consciousness. At this stage, the brain grows very quickly and the fetus will be fully aware of the inside and outside of the womb. The Eighth month will be ruled by is ruled by Rahu is called *Bhavana* denotes the abode, place and coming into existence. The feeling and connectivity will develop this month. The Ninth month is ruled by Ketu also called *Udvega* which means agitated. The fetus will be fully functional and excessive movement will take place. Likewise, Navagrahas will be responsible for the development of the fetus in nine months (Jyotish Digest, (2009). [6]).

He has hair and arms of gold. His chariot is pulled by seven ponies, which address the seven chakras. He directs as "Ravi" over "Ravi-var" or Sunday. In Hindu scripture, Surya is eminently considered as the noticeable type of God that one can see consistently. Besides, Shaivites and Vaishnavas frequently view Surya as a part of Shiva and Vishnu, separately. For instance, the sun is called Surya Narayana by Vaishnavas. In Shaivite philosophy, Surya is supposed to be one of eight types of Shiva, named the Astamurti. He was of Sattva Guna and addresses the Spirit, the Ruler, exceptionally positioned people or fathers. Chandra: Chandra is a lunar divinity. Chandra (moon) is otherwise called Soma and related to the Vedic Lunar divinity Soma. He is depicted as youthful, delightful, fair; two-outfitted and having a club in his grasp and a lotus. He rides his chariot (the moon) across the sky consistently, pulled by ten white ponies or a pronghorn. He is associated with dew, andone of the lords of fruitfulness accordingly. He is likewise called Nishadipati (Nisha=night; Adipathi=Lord) and Kshuparaka (one who enlightens the evening). He as Soma, manages Somvar or Monday. He is of Sattva Guna and addresses the Psyche, the Sovereign or Mother.

Mangala: Mangala is the divine force of Mars, the red planet. Mars is likewise called Angaraka ('one who is red in variety') or Bhauma ('child of Bhumi') in Sanskrit. He is the lord of war and is abstinent. He is viewed as the child of Prithvi or Bhumi, the Earth Goddess. He is the proprietor of the Aries and Scorpio signs, and an instructor of the mysterious sciences (Ruchaka Mahapurusha Yoga). He is of Tamas Guna in nature and describes vigorous activity, certainty and self-image. He is painted red or fire tone, four-equipped, conveying a harpoon, club, lotus and a lance. Budha: Mercury, also referred as the planet Budha, is thought to be the son of Tara (Taraka) and Chandra (the moon). The planet Budha refers to a god of goods and a protector of business people. He represents Communication and is of the Rajas Guna tribe. He is shown as being gentle, articulate, and having a greenish hue. In the Ramghur temple, he is potrayed riding a winged lion while wielding a scimitar, club, and shield. Other depictions show him riding an eagle, a carpet, or a chariot pulled by

He is the Guru, the god of knowledge and eloquence, to whom a number of works including the "atheistic" Barhaspatya sutras - are attributed. His orientation is northeast, and his Tattva, or element, is Akasha, or ether. He characterised as having a golden or yellow colouring and holding.

The planet is known as the Rajas in nature and stands for prosperity, pleasure, and procreation. It is thought to be a white colour. The Lord Ketu is also known as the Shadow God, and these two Grahas were created to be planetary gods. The mental feelings will develop in the Seventh month under the influence of Budha (Mercury). Hunger, thirst and taste will develop in the Eighth month by the planetary god Rahu and the Ketu will instil the desire to come out of the womb in the Ninth month to explore the world outside the womb. The auspicious and inauspicious developments of the fetus will be witnessed by the transition of the Planetary Gods - Navagrahas and their influence on the fetus in that particular month towards their development (S. P. Tata, [12]).




Fig. 1: Block Diagram of Similar Relations of Planetary Gods (9 Grahas), Fetal Development (9 Months) & Gods of Management (9 Ms)
